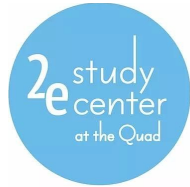


BREAKTHROUGHS IN TWICE-EXCEPTIONAL EDUCATION CONFERENCE



Breakthroughs 2021 Conference: Poster Sessions Invitation

The 2e Study Center at the Quad and The Quad Preparatory School invites 2e Clinicians, Educators, Providers, and Academics to submit a poster presentation for display during our Breakthroughs in Twice-Exceptional Education Conference. We are seeking posters on any scholarly work related to twice-exceptional education (teaching and learning) or the experiences of twice-exceptional individuals, which may include:

- Medical, nursing and health disciplines education
- Undergraduate, postgraduate, graduate and continuing education
- Patient and family education
- Interprofessional education
- Clinical work/therapeutic intervention
- Some examples of topics related to education may include:
 - New or innovative education programs or curricula
 - Evaluation of education programs
 - New teaching or evaluation methods
 - Innovations in education

The work may be completed or in-progress. If you are not sure if your work should be submitted, please contact us and we will be pleased to discuss further.

Poster Session Times/Dates:

Presenters should prepare a 3 to 5 minute presentation, highlighting the key components of their abstract. You will have an opportunity to interact directly with attendees at the Expo during the virtual conference. There will be a designated window on Thursday, March 11th from 12:00 noon to 1:00pm that presenters are required to be present at their booths to speak with interested attendees. In addition, presenters are strongly encouraged to spend 1–2 hours each day in their virtual “booth” to present posters and answer questions.

Poster Submission Instructions:

To apply for consideration, please submit your abstract, poster draft, and application form via this [Google Form](#) by **Friday, February 5th at 11:59pm (ET)**. Abstracts should be (300) words or less. Please include a copy of your poster for review with your submission (note that this does not need to be the final draft).

Poster Content Review:

The Breakthroughs Poster Sessions Committee will review the poster for content and antitrust compliance. The applicant will be notified by email via email on Monday, February 15th if the poster is accepted.

Poster Deadlines:

February 5th, 2021 — Poster Abstracts Due
February 15th, 2021 — Poster Acceptances confirmed to Author
March 10-12th, 2021 — Poster Sessions on display at Breakthroughs Conference

Set-Up and Presentation of Material:

All material should be in a form suitable for digital presentation, as poster sessions will take place as part of the “Expo Section” of our virtual conference. Presenters will have an opportunity to set up a virtual “booth” with their digital poster and subsequent information. Our Event Manager will be available to help setup if needed. Posters can be in the form of a video (with or without narration), an image, a PDF, etc.

All illustrations should be prepared in advance. Proper illustration is critical to an effective presentation. Legible size lettering, and minimal textual material is recommended. The use of colored text and backgrounds in framing textual material can be attractive, although artistic flair should not be excessive. It is the responsibility of the author to design and produce his/her digital poster.
